Protocol for Itinerant and Occasional Staff

For Reopening 2020



Itinerant or occasional staff will be moving from class to class or school to school and will have direct contact with multiple cohorts over the course of one school day. To reduce the risk of infection, staff shall adhere to the following:

- Ensure self-screening every time you arrive at a school
- Follow masking protocols at all time
- Properly wash hands before leaving one classroom and again before entering the next classroom
- Distance as much as possible while teaching
- Limit the touching of classroom surfaces
- Technology like computers and smart boards is to be disinfected between staff use using approved cleaning methods (wipes, or damp cloth or paper towel)
- Limit shared materials for students use materials that are already in the classroom as much as possible
- Carts can be used to bring materials from room to room, but should only contain materials that cannot be stored in individual classrooms
- Shared student materials are to be cleaned and disinfected before use by another cohort (e.g. musical instruments, sports equipment)
- If a space is to be shared by cohorts (e.g. NSL classes or 4s from a 3/4 split) desks and chairs must be wiped between cohorts, and can be part of student personal hygiene training
