TO THE CHAIR AND MEMBERS OF THE BUDGET COMMITTEE – Public Session

RE: 2015-2016 PRELIMINARY BUDGET

1. <u>Background</u>

- 1.1 On an annual basis, the Ministry of Education requires school boards in Ontario to submit a budget in accordance with Grants for Student Needs legislation (GSNs).
- 1.2 The funding regulation for the 2015-2016 fiscal year was released by the Ministry of Education on March 26, 2015. The budget announcement showed stable funding for the sector over the previous year, with several of the grants being restructured to focus on Ministry priorities.
- 1.3 Budget submissions are due to the Ministry by June 30, 2015.

2. Situation

Administration is concluding its preparation of the 2015-2016 budget as outlined in Appendix A, "2015-2016 Revenues", and Appendix B, "2015-2016 Expenditure Summary" and is presenting it for Trustees input and consideration.
