

## KINDERGARTEN LEARNING ACTIVITIES – JUNE 12<sup>th</sup>

Here are a variety of activities that you might like to try! Pick a few that interest you! Don't forget to have fun 😊



**We're Going On A Nature Hunt** When three friends take off on a lovely spring morning, they have no idea where the day will lead them. Together, they explore the beauty nature has to offer. And together, they have fun everywhere they go off on an adventure, or right here at home!

**Binocular Craft:** Before heading out on a scavenger hunt or collecting items for your nature museum you might want to create your very own binoculars to help you find those special items!

**What you need:**

Toilet paper tubes (x2)

Markers

String

Staples, glue or elastics

Stickers or anything to decorate your binoculars

**Step 1:** Decorate your tubes anyway you'd like

**Step 2:** Join the tubes together with staples, glue or an elastic

**Step 3:** Poke holes on both sides and through the middle (this is where you will feed your string through)

**Step 4:** Feed string (yarn, or shoelace will work) through the holes, make sure it is long enough that you don't need to untie it to take it off

Now you are all ready to go off on an adventure!



**Outdoor Scavenger Hunt:** If weather permits go outside and see how many of the items you can find on the scavenger hunt card. If it is raining, see how many items you can find inside. Don't forget to look high and look low. Happy searching!

**Nature Museum:** the purpose of this activity is to be curious outside, to have an adventure and notice things in your backyard, park, or on the side-walk

**What you need:**

- Egg Carton
- Marker

**Step 1:** Label the inside of the egg carton with opposite words:

- Hard – Soft
- Smooth – Rough
- Shiny – Dull
- Heavy – Light
- 4 Secret spots for special treasures you find

**Step 2:** Allow time for exploration outdoors so children can find objects that connect with each of the words labelled inside the egg carton

**Step 3:** Have your child share what they found.

**Bug Hunt:** Go on a bug hunt outside (if possible)! Roll over a log or stone, or look in the grass to see who lives nearby. Can you draw a picture of what you found? What do you notice about the bug (e.g., number of legs, number of antenna)?



**Nature Craft:** Using safe materials from the outdoors (if possible), create an animal or insect creation.

**Possible Extension:** Place your creation on a piece of paper. Can you create a speech bubble of what your creation might say?



**Penguin Race:** a fun activity you can do by yourself or with an adult. The object is to see how many times you can turn over the pail in 1 minute without dropping the ball that is in between your legs.

**What you need:**

- Ball or balloon
- 2 pails or yogurt containers



**Step 1:** Place the pails or containers 2 meters apart

**Step 2:** Start at one container and place the ball in between your knees

**Step 3:** See how many times you can turn over the containers in 1 minute without dropping the ball

**Music and Movement:** While singing the song, “Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes” or “The Hokey Pokey”, stop and create a rhyming word for each body part that is mentioned during the song (e.g., hand - band).



**Make a Menu:** Using magazines/flyers/drawings, glue/tape, and markers/pencil to create a menu together. This menu can be used during play (e.g., restaurant) or at daily meal times. Think about how much each item is going to cost? How can you show this? (e.g., tally marks, number, etc.).
