French Designated Early Childhood Educators

We will be accepting electronic applications beginning on **Friday, December 21, 2018 until 4:00pm on Friday, January 18, 2019 inclusive.**

Position Requirements:

- Qualified applicants will possess an Early Childhood Educator Diploma and current registration with the College of Early Childhood Educators. Unqualified applicants may be considered.

Each candidate shall submit the following:

- A covering letter;
- A resumé of qualifications and experience;
- A copy of the relevant diploma(s)/professional certificate(s) as required;
- A Reference Check Consent Form (available from Main Floor Reception, 2135 Sills Street or on the Board website under 'Careers').

Offer of employment is conditional upon the successful candidates:

- providing a current Police Record Check including Vulnerable Sector Screening dated (within the last 6 months); (this document **does not** need to be included in the application package).

Please Note:

- Interviews will be conducted partially in French.
- Unsuccessful candidates for permanent positions may be offered a position on the Board's Early Childhood Educator Supply List and/or the Board's Early Childhood Educator Permanent Hire List.

Application Procedure:

- Visit the board website at www.lakeheadschoools.ca and click on the 'Careers' link.
- Locate the posting for **French Designated Early Childhood Educator** and follow the '*Click here to apply*' link.
- To apply, select the category 'ECE, EA/TA/ERW, Clerical, Custodians, etc', and create your profile.

- Submit your application to the French Designated Early Childhood Educator job posting. You must ensure you are applying to the correct job posting within Apply to Education in order for your application to be considered.
- Applications will **only** be considered if submitted through Apply to Education. No other method of application will be accepted.

Applications must be received by **4:00pm on Friday, January 18, 2019**
