Mid-June, 2022 - Earliest Tuition Due Date

Application Fee \$95.00 (non-refundable)

Up to 5 program choices (no more than 3 at any one college)

UNIVERSITY PATHWAY

The completion of the Ontario Secondary School Diploma with a minimum overall average and six Grade 12 U or M courses, will be necessary for consideration for admission to an Ontario university. Some universities and/or programs have higher admission averages than others. Check up-to-date information provided at university websites. For out of province universities, check the specific school's website for information.

November 2021 - Student PIN numbers mailed to the school and can be picked up in Student Services

January 13, 2022 – Equal Consideration Date to apply by

May 27, 2021 - Date to expect an admission response by (offer of admission, refusal, or deferral of admission)

June 1, 2021 - Deadline to Confirm Offers of Admission and provide a financial commitment

Application Fee \$150.00 (non-refundable) -- For the initial three university/program choices

*Additional choice fee \$50.00 (no more than 3 programs at any one university)

*Additional \$10 International Service Fee (if not a Canadian citizen or permanent resident)
