Application Information

Lakehead Public Schools is now accepting applications for an Indigenous Student Trustee 2022-23

To qualify, you must be:

- a self-identified First Nations, Metis, or Inuit (FNMI);
- a Canadian Citizen;
- a resident within the area of jurisdiction of Lakehead Public Schools;
- a full-time student in the senior division at Lakehead Public Schools; or,
- an exceptional pupil in a special education program from whom the Board has reduced the length of the instruction program on each school day under subsection 3(3) of Regulation 298 of the Revised Regulation of Ontario, 1990 (Operation of Schools - General) made under the Act, so long as the pupil would be a full-time pupil if the program had not been reduced.

Application forms are available from the Indigenous Student Leadership Team or the Student Council President at your Secondary School. Each Secondary School may submit one application for the Indigenous Student Trustee.

Please see your Student Council or Indigenous Student Leadership team for the application process and deadline to apply for your school.

The final candidate's application must be submitted by the school no later than February 18, 2022 at 4:30 PM. Late applications will not be accepted.
