  - the needs continue to increase for students with special needs supports that unfortunately do not match the funding received by the board;
  - our focus continues to be on junior kindergarten to grade 3, and there may be a need for another special needs classroom. We currently have (2) at Westmount Public School, (1) at Algonquin Avenue Public School with an additional (1) multi-needs classroom, (1) Vance Chapman Public School, (1) at Hammarskjold High School, and (1) at Westgate Collegiate and Vocational Institute; and
  - upcoming professional development for administration on special education-autism spectrum disorder (ASD), followed by legal implications.
