

2026 – 2027 SUPERIOR C.V.I. COURSE REQUESTS HELPFUL INFORMATION

Course selections must be entered and submitted in Xello by **MARCH 4, 2026.**

- * Courses may be subject to cancellation if not enough students select them.
- * Please note that the credit count in Xello may not be accurate. Always rely on your Ontario Student Status Sheet.

CURRENT GRADE 9s (choose 8 courses for Grade 10)

For grade 10, you will choose **six (6) compulsory courses** [including 0.5 Civics (CHV205) and 0.5 Career Studies (GLC205). You will also choose **three (3) optional credits**.

- * If you did not take a tech course in grade 9, you must select a grade 10 tech course.
- * If you need to repeat a gr. 9 compulsory course, please include the course with your requests.

CURRENT GRADE 10s (choose 8 courses for Grade 11)

For Grade 11, you will choose **two (2) compulsory courses** (English and Math) plus **six (6) optional credits**.

- * Check to see if you have your STEM credit completed (check your Student Status Sheet).
- * Consider courses you may be required to take in Grade 12 as prerequisites for post-secondary programs and destinations.

CURRENT GRADE 11s (choose 6-8 courses for Grade 12)

For Grade 12, you will choose **one (1) compulsory course** (English) and **five to seven (5-7) optional courses**.

- * Ensure you meet graduation requirements.
- * Students wishing to attend college or university are reminded that they must meet specific entrance requirements:
 - University – at least (6) Grade 12 “U” or “M” courses, including ENG 4U1, and often a designated overall average. Students must also meet course prerequisites for certain post-secondary programs. (www.ontariouniversitiesinfo.ca)
 - College – ENG4C1. Check programs for specific senior math or science prerequisites. (www.ontariocolleges.ca)
 - Workplace / Apprenticeship – consider Cooperative Education and OYAP. (skilledtradesontario.ca, www.apprenticesearch.com, www.oyp.com)

CURRENT GRADE 12s / POTENTIAL GRADUATES

- If you are not returning next year, select NRT100 and NRT200 **OR** → (Option: if you are graduating and not returning, please return to Student Services signed)
- If you are returning for semester one only, select NRT200 and three to four (3-4) courses for semester one.
- If you are graduating, but planning on a victory lap, please contact your Guidance Counsellor.
