This position will provide an educational environment where students can develop knowledge, skills, attitudes and values required to safely interact with the natural environment. The successful candidate will work with students from grades one through twelve.

The successful candidate:

- Develops and instructs curriculum relevant educational programs through outdoor activities which highlight learning objectives
- Supervises, monitors, evaluates, mentors and inspires students by providing them structured opportunities to observe, and participate in outdoor programs
- Provides equipment, facilities and programs for community users
- Operates and maintains various equipment (ie. chainsaw, boat, snow machine, ATV, water pump, scientific equipment, etc.)

Qualifications:

- Must have a diploma/degree in a related field
- Related outdoor experience, preferably with children
- Ontario Recreation Canoe Association Flatwater Instructor or equivalent would be an asset
- X-country Ski Instructor would be an asset
- Certified in First Aid/CPR
- Valid driver's license
